First layer of data protection

Controller	Miguel Hernández University of Elche.
Purposes	Manage, process, verify, and resolve applications and/or administrative procedures corresponding to Continuing Education Activities, Courses and Programs.
Legal basis	Compliance with legal obligations, the performance of a mission carried out in the public interest, and the exercise of official authority vested in the UMH.
Data consultation	The UMH may consult or verify, through data exchange platforms or other authorized electronic systems, any data and documents required to confirm compliance with the requirements of the procedure, in accordance with Article 28 of Law 39/2015 and the eighth additional provision of the LOPDGDD.
Rights	Interested parties may exercise their rights of access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, portability, where appropriate, and to object , in accordance with the provisions of data protection regulations.

<p>PERIOD OF TIME DATA IS STORED</p> <p>Data shall be stored for as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose for which it was collected and to determine possible responsibilities deriving from said purpose and from the processing of the data.</p> <p>In all cases, the general provisions of legislation governing public administration records and archives shall apply.</p>
<p>RIGHTS</p> <p>You may exercise your rights of access, rectification, opposition, erasure, data portability, and restriction of processing by submitting the <i>Ejercicio de derechos en materia de protección de datos</i> (Exercise of Data Protection Rights) form via a UMH Registry or by any other legally valid means, addressed in care of the Legal Services-Data Protection</p>
